

**Information Booklet for NRI/NRI Sponsored category
to the First Year Degree Architecture Course
at VVP Sanchalit Indubhai Parekh School of Architecture-Rajkot
After 12 Science/Commerce stream for the Academic year 2009-10**

This information is for the admission to the first year degree Architecture courses comprising 15% of sanctioned seats under NRI/ NRI Sponsored Category Quota as per the Govt of Gujarat guidelines.

1. Seats Available for Admission

15% of the seats from all the seats for Indubhai Parekh School of Architecture are as under: Institute / Branch	Sanctioned Intake For A.Y. 2009-10	(85%) To Be Filled By ACPC (Gujarat State)	(15%) NRI/ NRI Sponsored Category

Definition of NRI / NRI Sponsored Candidate:

"Non Resident Indian Seats" means fifteen percent, seats reserved for children or wards or the dependents for the education purpose, of the Non - Resident Indian, to whom admission is to be given in the professional educational colleges or institutions.

2. Eligibility Criteria

- (1) For the purpose of admission , a candidate shall have passed the qualifying examination form
 - (i) The Gujarat Board; **Or**
 - (ii) The Central Board of Secondary Education Board provided that,-
 - (a) The school in which the candidate has studied should have been located in the State of Gujarat; or
 - (b) The school in which the candidate has studied, should have been located in the Union Territories of Diu, Daman and Dadra Nagar Haveli and whose parents are origin of Gujarat. **Or**
 - (iii) The Council of Indian School Certificate Examination. New Delhi provided that,-
 - (a) The school in which the candidate has studied, should have been located in the State of Gujarat; or the school in which the candidate has studied, should have been located in the Union Territories of Diu. Daman and Dadra Xagar Haveli and whose parents are origin of Gujarat- and
 - (iv) Pass out in the NATA Test **year,-In case of,-**
 - (a) a degree in engineering or technology course, passed with "Mathematics" or "Statistics":
- (2) A candidate whose parents are origin of Gujarat and who are serving out of Gujarat in the service of Central Government or other State Governments, Military, Boards or Corporations own or controlled by the Central Government or other State Governments or any nationalized bank and who have passed the qualifying examination from Central Board of Secondary Education or the Council of Indian School Certificate Examinations. New Delhi or the respective State Boards and Passed the NATA Test shall be eligible for admission and his candidature shall be included in the first merit list (Gujarat Board Merit List).
- (3) A candidate who has passed the qualifying examination and.-
 - (i) Has passed the NAT A Test and
 - (ii) Whose parents are serving in the category of service as shown below; and
 - (iii) Who are transferred from other States to Gujarat and have resumed their duty in the place where they are transferred in Gujarat shall be eligible for admission and his candidature shall be included in the second merit list (Central Board Merit List):

3. Procurement of Application Form:

a)"Application form can be obtained from Indubhai Parekli School of Architecture V.V.P. College Campus. Rajkot by paying fees of Rs. 300/- in cash .

OR

b)" Admission Information and Application form can also be downloaded from the website: www.ipsaraikot.org and Rs. 300/- cash should be paid at the time of submission of the form.

4. Mark-Sheet / Certificates to be attached with Application Form

Candidate shall have to attach self-attested copy of mark sheets of Standard 10, Standard 12, NATA Score Card - correction letter (if any) and school leaving certificate. A copy of passport of sponsor and affidavit in case admission is desired under NRI/NRI sponsored will have to be produced at the time of admission.

5. Submission of Application Form

(a) Duly filled in application form along with necessary mark sheets certificates should be submitted in person within the prescribed time limit at VVP Sanchalit Indubhai Parekli School of Architecture, Rajkot.

(b) The form is not acceptable by post or courier.

(c) In case of submission of more than one application by a candidate, the latest application recorded up to the last date for accepting application shall be taken into consideration for admission and the rest shall be treated as cancelled.

6. Preparation of Merit List

The merit list of the candidates who have applied for admission in the prescribed form, within the prescribed time limit and who are found eligible for admission under these rules, shall be prepared in the following manner, namely:-

- (1) (a) The candidates who have passed qualifying examination, fifty percentage of marks NATA Score fifty percentage shall be the merit marks.
- (2) The admission committee shall prepare and publish separate merit lists, namely:-
 - (a) The first merit list shall include the candidates who have passed the qualifying examination from the Gujarat Board. Merit list of reserved category candidates shall be prepared separately;
 - (b) The second merit list shall consist of two separate merit list, namely:-
 - (i) The candidates who have passed the qualifying examination from the Central Board of Secondary Education, and
 - (ii) The candidates who have passed the qualifying examination from the Council of Indian School Certificate Examinations. New Delhi,
 - (iii) The available Seats shall be distributed on pro-rata basis taking into considerations the number of students passed from the Central Board of Secondary Education and Council of Indian School Certificate Examinations, New Delhi in the current academic year. Merit list of reserved category candidates shall be prepared separately.
- (3) The criteria for deciding merit order iii case of students having equal merit marks shall be in the following sequence,, namely:-
 - (a) For Architeciure courses: Marks obtained in Mathematics in qualifying examination,
 - (b) Marks obtained in Secondary School Certificate Examination (Standard 10), and
 - (c) Date of Birth (Candidate who is older in age shall be given priority).

7. Distribution of Seats among Students of Gujarat Board and Other Boards

Distribution of seats among students of Gujarat Secondary and Higher Secondary Education Board and other Boards shall be done on pro-rata basis taking into account the number of students passed from both the Boards in the relevant year as conforming to ACPC (Gujarat State.)

8. Admission Procedure

- 8.1 Merit list and admission program shall be displayed only on website: www.ipsarajkot.org and on the notice boards of Indubhai Parekh School of .Architecture. Rajkot. Candidate will not be informed individually regarding merit list and admission program.

8.2 Candidate shall have to remain present personally for admission at VVP Sanchalit Indubhai Parekh School of Architecture VVP College Campus, Rajkot at the scheduled date and time. However, if candidate is unable to remain present personally on the date of admission due to serious illness / accident or any such unavoidable circumstances, his/her guardian could remain present on the prescribed date and time, along with an authority letter and option letter from the candidate.

8.3 Candidate approaching the Indubhai Parekh School of Architecture VVP College Campus, Rajkot with written application after the date and time she/he was called at scheduled time, shall be given admission at available seat and branch in the respective category at that point of time. However, no right shall remain on branch available at the originally given time schedule.

9. Fees

Once, the offer is made for admission, the Candidate shall have to pay the fees immediately, as mentioned below:

The exchange rate shall be 1 US \$ = Rs 47/- for present year. However, the fee may vary time to time as per the condition prevailing at the time payment of fees.

10. As it is an admission on the base of NRI/NRI Sponsored quota, any kind of reshuffling /cancellation of the admission will not be permitted. However, in case of cancellation of the admission, candidate will have to pay the full NRI quota fees of five years.
